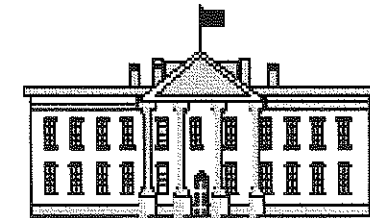
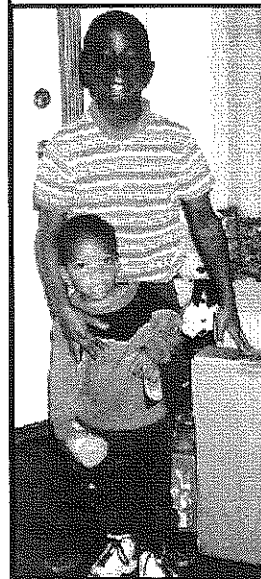


The important thing about Kane is that he LOVES history because it's important and fun to learn.

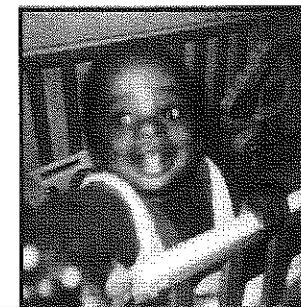
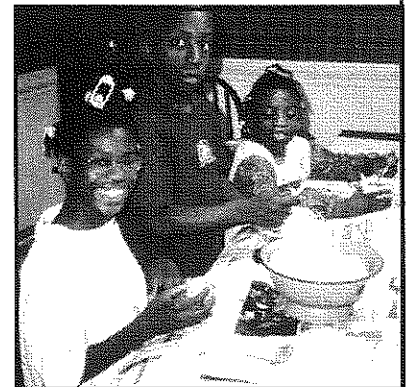

You will be very sorry you ever knew me.

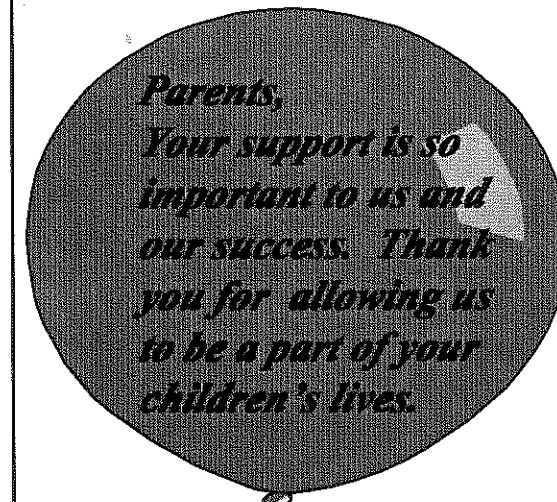
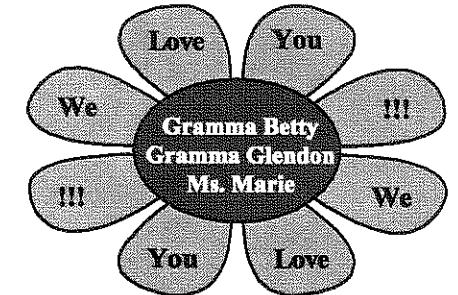

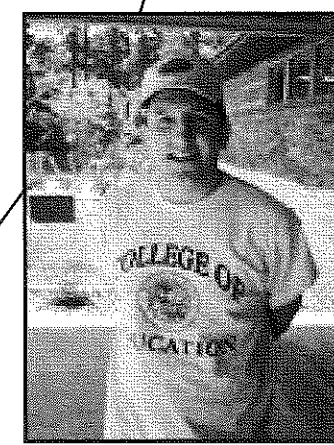

Ms. Cathy makes sure we're safe crossing the streets.

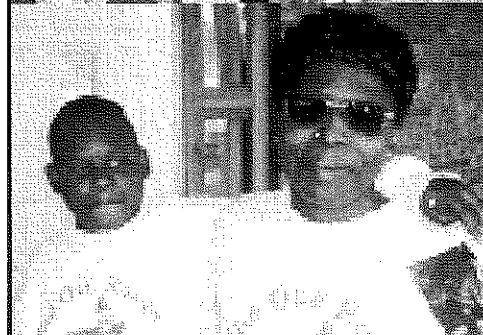
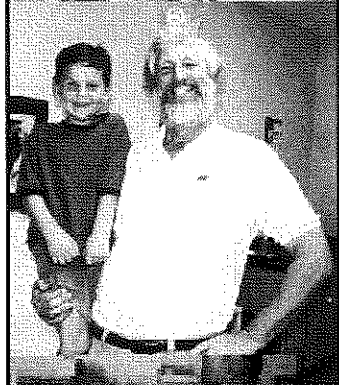
